

When Will I Get My *Statement of Benefits*?

The Department will begin distributing the 2010 *Statement of Benefits* in mid-April. This is the document distributed annually to active and inactive members, providing individual information on their Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS) WRS account.

If you are currently employed under the WRS, your *Statement* will be sent to your employer and your employer will give it to you. If you worked for more than one employer, your *Statement* will be sent to the employer with your most recent WRS begin date.

If you are no longer employed by a WRS participating employer but still have a WRS account, or if you received a portion of your former spouse's WRS account through a Qualified Domestic Relations Order, your *Statement* will be mailed directly to your last known address on file with the Department.

You will not receive a *Statement* if you are retired and receiving a monthly annuity (unless you still have additional contributions from which you have not taken a benefit), or if you have closed your account by taking a lump sum benefit.
